Fort Spokane, located at the confluence of the Columbia and Spokane River is part of the Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area. The area is rich with history from Grand Coulee Dam and the Spokane Indian Tribe. From Spokane, go West 32 miles on Hwy 2 to the town of Davenport. Then go North 24 miles on State Hwy 25. If you cross the river you have gone too far.

Two Rivers Casino is just across the Spokane River. They have lots of good Food, Gambling, RV Park, Store and House Boat rentals.

After that you will need to contact the park and reserve a campsite in the regular campground next to us. The cost is \$10 per night. Boat launching is also available for a small fee.
