extension cords, **quiet** generators, batteries, fuel, snacks, etc. Also, **bring your own shade.**

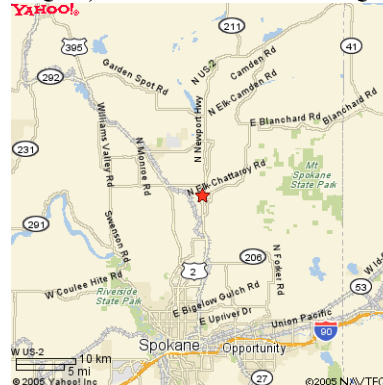
Please note: **there are no trees at the south end of the park where we will be located, so "tip-up" antennas are suggested.**

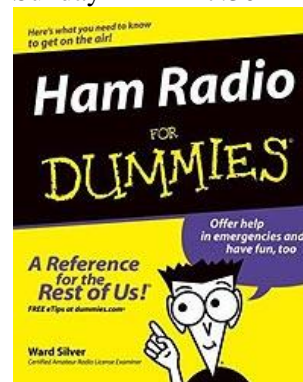
